## Sample Pastor Letter #1 Planning for a post-pandemic parish

My dear sisters and brothers in Christ —

This is one of those letters I've looked forward to writing for what feels like a very long time! The purpose of this letter is to tell you about the plans we're making at [name of parish] to resume normal operations following months and months of precautionary measures due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Bishop [Name] has advised us that the general dispensation for the obligation to attend Sunday Mass will be lifted on [date]. What does this mean? We've missed you! And we're eager to reconnect with you and welcome you back to active participation in our parish.

Even for those who have already returned to weekly Mass, this is a time of renewal! We've all gone through a difficult time that has challenged our faith in many ways. We may have experienced ill health or cared for loved ones who suffered with Covid or other illnesses throughout this ordeal. Many of our families have suffered employment and financial difficulties. Still others of us have lost loved ones, and for most of those dearly departed, we were not able to adequately mourn together as a community. As your pastor, this, in particular, is something that has weighed on my heart.

And so, now that the restrictions from gathering as a parish community are ending, I invite all of us to prepare to **Return, Renew, and Rediscover** the precious gift of our Catholic faith! **Welcome to [name of parish]!** This is *your* parish, *your* faith community, and *your* spiritual home!
