Sample Pastor Letter #2 Announcement of changes/plans

My dear sisters and brothers in Christ —

We are rejoicing that we are now able to gather under one roof once more to worship the Lord together!

While the COVID virus numbers are declining and some restrictions have been lifted, there are still some steps we can take to keep each other safe and healthy. As we join our parish family at Mass, you'll notice some things that look a little different than they used to be.

Although there is no water, please take a moment to prayerfully make the sign of the cross and remember the baptismal promises that made you part of the family of Christ.
